

Average Median Income (AMI) Reduction in Monetary Threshold

Pursuant to Election Law § 14-203(2), in order to be eligible for public matching funds, a participating candidate must raise a minimum threshold amount of money and receive a minimum number of matchable contributions. For example, candidates running for the New York State Assembly must raise a minimum of \$6,000 in matchable contributions and receive at least 75 matchable contributions (\$5-\$250) from in-district residents.

In districts where the median household income is below the state's median household income, the minimum monetary threshold for eligibility is reduced by one-third. This means that in such districts, the monetary threshold for the State Assembly would be reduced to \$4,000.

Below is a list of Assembly Districts that qualify for the reduced \$4,000 threshold.
