**Resolution 24-03**

**Resolution Authorizing Public Matching Funds to Participating Candidates for  
the 2024 Primary Election**

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Title II of Article 14 of the Election Law, participating candidates in the New York State Public Matching Funds program that meet program requirements and thresholds and that are certified on the 2024 ballot for the Office of Member of the State Senate or the Office of Member of the State Assembly are eligible to receive public matching funds;

**WHEREAS**, the primary election for State Senate and State Assembly will be held on June 25, 2024, and the first issuance of public matching funds to eligible participating candidates is scheduled for May 13, 2024;

**WHEREAS**, the New York State Public Campaign Finance Board staff has audited and determined that seven (7) State Senate Committees and thirty (30) State Assembly Committees have met the requirements and thresholds outlined in Title II of Article 14 of the Election Law and are eligible to receive a public matching fund payment based on their individual fundraising performance;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the New York State Public Campaign Finance Board authorizes payment to the committees listed on the attached report, “Commissioner Report for the Approval to Disperse Public Matching Funds – Board Meeting Date: 5/7/2024;” and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the New York State Public Campaign Finance Board authorizes payment to People for Larinda – filer identification number 382225 - in Assembly District 35, in the amount of \$46,010.48, once the committee has successfully set up their account in the Statewide Financial System, to be able to accept an electronic fund transfers; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the New York State Public Campaign Finance Board authorizes payment to Elijah for Senate 2024 – filer identification

number 360694 - in State Senate District 38, in the amount of \$5,000, once the committee has successfully set up their account in the Statewide Financial System to be able to accept an electronic fund transfers.
